In Los Angeles, Ray is sitting in gridlock when he receives a call from an LAPD officer about his wife. Fearing the worst, he listens intently—but suddenly the caller and everyone else around him disappears. In London, the moment two commuters catch sight of each other on a packed Monday morning Tube train, everyone around them vanishes. In Japan, comics artist Yoshi has come to the Aokigahara Forest to hang himself. But when the attempt fails and he slides free, the forest comes alive with mythological creatures.
